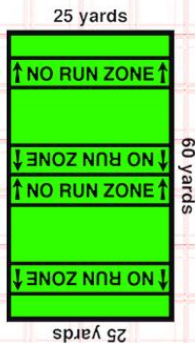

THE FIELD OF PLAY

Length of field is 60 yards plus eight yard end-zone.
Width of field is 25 yards from side line to side line.

SCORING

Six points for a touchdown. One point for conversion from 5 yard line, two points for a conversion from 12 yard line. Two points for a safety.

PASSING

All players eligible to receive passes. 1 forward pass per down. QB on 7 second pass clock.

RUNNING

Running is allowed except in no-run zones. QB can not run. Only direct hand-offs are allowed.

OVERTIME RULES

If score is tied, overtime is played directly after 26 minutes. Coin toss determines possession. Each team receives one (1) play from their own 5 yard line. The team gaining the most yardage is declared the winner. Teams can not score points, only positive and negative yardage. All penalty rules apply in overtime.

PUNTS, BLOCKING & RUSHING

No punts, no blocking, and a 5 second delay rush and/or 7 yard drop from line of scrimmage.

CLEATS & MOUTHPIECES

Cleats are allowed but must be rubber. No metal spikes are allowed. All players must wear a protective mouthpiece. If you do not have a mouthpiece, one is available on-site for a fee.

TIME OF THE GAME

Games are played for twenty-six minutes, two 13 minute halves. The time between plays must not exceed 30 seconds (unless stopped by Referee). The game clock will stop only as long as the referee deems necessary for penalties and injuries. The clock will also stop for team timeouts. Each team is allowed (1) 60 second time-out.

POSSESSIONS

A coin flip before the start of the game will determine who gets the ball first. All drives and change of possession (except interceptions) start at the 5 yard line. Possessions starting as a result of an interception begin at the point of interception. Interceptions can be run back.

THE MOVEMENT OF THE BALL

The offense has 3 plays to cross the mid-field line or score a touchdown.
